# Fluco-Sol (Fluconazole), a recommendation to use light-protection in order to avoid the risk of incorrect storage.

#### Dear Healthcare professional,

In agreement with the Saudi Food and Drug Authority (SFDA), PSI as the marketing authorization holder for Fluco-sol would like to inform you of the following:

#### SUMMARY

- Fluco-Sol (Fluconazole) should be stored in the outer carton to reduce incorrect storage risk. As a precaution, light-proof amber resistance bags are recommended when unable to store the product in the outer cartons to prevent photosensitivity.
- The Summary of Product Characteristics (SPC) will be updated as appropriate to reflect the latest data and recommendations.

#### Background on the safety concern:

- Fluconazole is indicated in the following fungal infections: Cryptococcal meningitis, Coccidioidomycosis, Invasive candidiasis, Mucosal candidiasis including oropharyngeal, esophageal candidiasis, candiduria and chronic mucocutaneous candidiasis. The purpose of this letter is to encourage HCPs to use light-protection to prevent Fluco-sol from being incorrectly stored.
- Fluconazole belongs to the class of medicines known as triazole antifungals which it has a photosensitive activity lead to degradation of drug with potential toxic or allergizing effects for the human body, according on that should be **protected from light** to prevent the effect on light on such medication.
- A light-proof amber resistance bags are recommended when unable to store the product in the outer cartons to prevent photosensitivity.
- Storage temperatures do not exceed 25°C.

## CALL FOR REPORTING

Reporting suspected adverse reactions after authorization of the medicinal product is important.

It allows continued monitoring of the benefit/risk balance of the medicinal product.
