What is Ferriprox and Ferriprox MR?

- Ferriprox contains the active substance deferiprone. Ferriprox is an iron chelator, a type of medicine that is used to remove excess iron from the body.
- Ferriprox is used for the treatment of iron overload in patients with thalassaemia major when current chelation therapy is inadequate.
- Ferriprox can be used in combination with another iron chelator if your doctor has determined that treatment with any iron chelator alone has been ineffective or if your condition requires rapid or intensive correction of the excess iron in your body.
